### Artist application Terms and conditions

- Applicants are not expected to submit 'We Believe' themed artwork within the application- decisions will be based upon examples of previous works
- Artists will be selected via a panel of 3 individuals from various organisations
- Applications must be submitted by 22<sup>nd</sup> June 2020
- Successful artists will be notified by 24<sup>th</sup> June 2020
- All successful artists must submit completed artwork by 8th July 2020
- Artists can choose their medium but completed work will also need to be submitted digitally for print reproduction at A1 size (minimum 300 dpi resolution)
- Portsmouth Creates retains physical ownership of the original artworks submitted which may be used as part of the Crowdfunding reward scheme
- Portsmouth Creates will also own the copyright of the pieces, you will be able to share images of your work where appropriate, for example in a CV, an online gallery or portfolio
- Wherever the artwork is used for publicity, marketing or education purposes Portsmouth Creates will always acknowledge the artist
- Submitted artwork must be original and not used previously within a Portsmouth Creates Project
- Portsmouth Creates may withdraw an offer at any time if the artwork is deemed to be inappropriate & artwork must not depict political or religious beliefs
- Only artists who have not received either a 'Small Business Grant' or 'Leisure, Retail & Hospitality Grant' are eligible to apply
- Artists agree to sign print copies of their work to be offered as 'rewards' via the Crowdfunder scheme
- Final artwork needs to include artist name/details for exhibition purposes
- Artists agree to provide artist information for Portsmouth Cretes website
